In recent years our Day for Life Collection has helped fund our traditional pro-life organisations as well as supporting survivors of sexual abuse and those with addictions and caring for refugees and asylum seekers. This year’s theme, *The Lord is My Shepherd*, focuses on Compassion and Hope at the End of life against current efforts to legalise assisted euthanasia.
