GENERAL ELECTION AND PRO-LIFE

The recent letter from the Bishops' Conference of Scotland, urging Catholics to keep the Church's teaching in mind when voting in next week's election, highlighted first and foremost the right to life. All other rights are secondary to this fundamental right. Whoever represents us in Westminster will likely be asked to vote on decriminalising abortion and legalising assisted suicide.
