GIFT-AID AND LOOSE CASH DONATIONS 2023-2024 TAX RECLAIM

At the end of the 2023-2024 Financial Year on 5th April, the Gift-Aid and Loose Cash records of the two parishes during the said period were updated and submitted to the Diocesan Finance Office for Tax reclaim. I am pleased to inform you that from St. Pius and St Patrick, the sum of £1,466.25 and £1,135.25 was reclaimed from gift aided donations, and £2,000.00 from the non-gift aided Small Donations Scheme, respectively, making it a total of £3,466.25 from St. Pius X, and £3,135.25 from St. Patrick's being reclaimed from HMRC during that Tax Year.
